

Warning regarding the use of artificial intelligence in drafting complaints

A complaint addressed to the Conseil de la magistrature must be written by the complainant and describe the conduct attributed to the judge.

Your complaint is expected to reflect **your own observations of the judge's conduct**. This step is essential because the analysis of a complaint relies notably on the facts reported by the complainant, their perception of the situation, the impressions they formed, and the elements they consider significant based on their experience with the judge in question.

Using artificial intelligence tools to generate a complaint can alter its content by introducing phrasing or interpretations that do not match your actual experience. It can also distort your complaint by omitting relevant details or, conversely, by making it unnecessarily complex in a way that does not reflect reality.

You may choose to use an **artificial intelligence tool as a drafting aid**—for example, to clarify your ideas, correct the language, or structure your text. However, the content of your complaint should be your own: written simply, in your own words, and faithful to your actual experience.

Finally, please note that the **Conseil de la magistrature will contact you, if necessary**, to obtain **further details** regarding the **conduct** you attribute to the judge. It is therefore important that the content of your complaint accurately reflects **your own experience**.
